
Dear Classmates:

As many of you may recall, we wrote to you in 2006 regarding the re-election of one of our former classmates, **Judge Sally Lundberg Montgomery** (HPHS, Class of '67), to her second term as Judge of County Court at Law No. 3, Dallas County. Judge Montgomery is now seeking her third term as Judge of that Court and we, again, wholeheartedly endorse her re-election. We do not endorse her because of a party affiliation (she appears on the ballot on the Democratic ticket) but because Judge Montgomery is, without question, the better qualified candidate for the position.


Judge Montgomery has fourteen (14) years of judicial experience, sitting on both a District Court bench and the County Court at Law bench. She has served with distinction, establishing that she has the demeanor, temperament and knowledge necessary for the job. Judge Montgomery has been recognized by her peers, having been elected by her fellow Court-at-Law judges as Dallas County's representative to the Texas Association of Statutory Courts-at-Law from 2005 to present, is the only judge sitting in Dallas County to be certified as a Civil Trial Judge by the Texas Center for the Judiciary, and has received the Presidential Commendation for individual leadership in improving justice statewide by the State Bar of Texas. She has the highest disposition rate of the 18 Dallas civil court judges from 2003 to the present, and a low reversal rate, having been reversed less than one tenth of one percent of more than 22,000 cases as a County Court at Law judge. Judge Montgomery has been awarded the Certificate of Special Competence in the field of Civil Jurisprudence at the Texas College for Judicial Studies from 2005 to the present.

We believe Judge Montgomery has done and will continue to do an excellent job on the bench and urge you to support her with your vote.
